



CABOOLTURE GOLF CLUB

LOCAL RULES

1. Sprinkler Heads: Within 2 club lengths of the green or the ball is 2 club lengths from a sprinkler head and is on the line of play. Relief is allowed under Rule 16.1(a).
2. Washouts and casual water in bunkers – treat as Abnormal Course Conditions, relief allowed in bunker.
3. Wheel tracks on fairways, outcrops of rocks, artificial surfaces and imported materials on paths and roads are Abnormal Course Conditions and relief may be taken without penalty.
4. Grates in bunkers interfering with play. Relief drop allowed in bunker.
5. Areas in a bunker obviously damaged by kangaroos, drop in the bunker, at nearest point of relief for no penalty (Rule 16.1c/1), alternatively, penalty relief of 1 shot outside the bunker in your relief area (Rule 16.1c/2).
6. Buggy signs and hoops through the green are movable objects and must be replaced after shot is played.
7. 12th and 13th holes – Bridges on the fairways are Abnormal Course Conditions and relief may be taken without penalty.
8. All penalty areas and GUR stakes are Immoveable Objects and relief may be taken without penalty except if the ball is in the penalty area.
9. All Mobile Phones must be either turned off or the volume turned down – Conduct Rule 1.2a/1. They can be used as a measuring device only.
10. All golf carts are to be parked no closer than 10m from the green.
11. All garden beds defined or not defined are PENALTY AREAS.
12. Fences on the 3rd, 8th and 12th are Line of Sight relief.
13. All boundary fences and black and white pegged areas are Out of Bounds and a provisional ball must be played from the point of origin of first shot.
14. If your ball strikes any powerlines, electrical towers/poles on the course you MUST replay your shot without penalty.
15. The area between the 4th and 5th holes is ALL penalty area.

NEW RULES.

16. The area around the 4 buggy sheds are OB as defined by black and white pegs. Hit a provisional.
17. The private garden bed across the road DIRECTLY behind the 2nd green is GUR a free relief drop is given on the left side of the back of the green no nearer to the hole (near the club sign).
18. The private garden encroaching on the left side of the 6th fairway is a RED penalty area - normal penalty rules apply (Rule 17)

TEMPORARY RULES

1. All Irrigation works are GUR.
2. Bare patches on the fairways are a relief drop.
3. Mulch spread on the course is not a free drop you must play off it.
4. All works pertaining to tree lopping are GUR.
5. Piles of mulch pertaining to tree lopping are free relief and line of sight relief.
