CLUBHOUSE

The entire top floor of the clubhouse is dedicated to your entertainment and providing a place to catch up with members before or after your game. Access can be gained by a lift or by internal stairs.

Poker machines and a pool table are available for member and visitor use as well as the Golf Simulators.

Unfortunately, the Fairways Bistro is currently not operational.

Sandwiches and the like can be purchased from the bar.

A D.O.S.A. (smoking area) is provided on the ground floor at the southern end of the clubhouse (near the 18th green). Access can be gained through the walkway between the proshop and the members' toilets and locker room.

The clubhouse also provides a venue for weddings, parties etc with décor to suit most events.

It is also a well used facility for conferences and staff training for organisations within the community.

PRO SHOP

The proshop is located on the ground floor of the clubhouse. Here vou are able to sign in for your game, pay your competition and green fees and purchase all manner of golf equipment and a limited number of refreshments.

You can also book motorised golf carts, lessons, golf simulator time as well as make bookings for future competition or social rounds.

The proshop staff offer club repairs as well as arranging club fitting at the local TaylorMade swing lab.

CLUB OFFICE

The club's office is staffed Monday to Friday - opening at 8:30am and closing at 4:00pm. Contact 07 5495 1033 ext 2

PARKING

Currently, there are three parking areas available for member use. The first is on the left of the driveway into the course. This is primarily used by players who bring their own carts to the course. The main car park situated in front of the clubhouse is available for use by members and a third parking area west of the clubhouse is also available.

MEMBER CARTS

Cart space is provided on a 'user pays' basis on course.

This is subject to availability. Currently we have 80 secure spaces in 4 sheds. Charging equipment and a cleaning facility are included in the rental fees.

All members' carts must be registered with the club and are subject to annual fees.



Lockers

These are situated on the ground floor of the clubhouse near the men's toilets. Enquire at the office for availability and cost.

TOILETS

Situated upstairs and downstairs of the clubhouse as well as a couple of facilities on course - one at the back of the second tee and another just to the left of the 15th fairway.

WOMEN'S LOCKER ROOM

Situated on the ground floor just past the ProShop.

PRACTICE AREAS

Caboolture Golf Club offers a number of different short game practice areas.

The practice putting green in front the clubhouse is a great place to practice your putting. Next to the practice putting green is where you can practice your chipping and bunker play.

For your pre-game warm up as well as practice, swing nets are located to the right of the first fairway near the members' buggy sheds. Please observe the signage as to what clubs to use.

A short walk through the western car park and across the 13th fairway bridge will bring you to another practice facility.

Here you can practice pitching, short to long irons as well as hybrids. Use of driver is not permitted here because of the potential danger to players on the 13th fairway.

Inside the clubhouse we have two golf simulators that can cater for your practice with ALL clubs in your bag.

Just book a time and booth through the Proshop.



PADDY'S BAR AND GRILL

This is open on Saturdays for the members and guests playing in the major weekly competition.

Open from early morning to mid afternoon, it provides a range of eats and drinks to meet your needs.

It may also open on Sunday for Social Clubs depending on demand.

MEMBER POINTS AND CLUB CASH

The Caboolture Golf Club operates a member house points system as part of its operations.

There are two components to the system:

- Member Points
 - ◆ These are accumulated by players by placing in club competitions as well as winning NTP's or Approaches. These points remain active for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of winning. If they are not 'spent' within that 12 month time period, they are lost. You can find out how many points you have by swiping your membership card when you sign in upstairs before entering the bar area
 - These points can be redeemed in the Proshop, the bar and Paddy's Bar and Grill. You simply use your membership card to make the transaction.
- Club Cash
 - Members may choose to add cash to their membership card and use that card for 'in club' transactions whenever you

It also provides access to the club's Fixture Book and Calendar.

Access to the Members Only area is also available via a link.

This area requires a login and a password which are provided to you once membership is confirmed.

The Member Login provides access to the private MiClub site where you can:



- Book tee times
- Check your handicap
- Find contact details of other members and update your own
- Check your playing statistics

CLUBTALK

This is a monthly publication delivered to your registered email address. This will keep you in touch with what is happening around the club. It is usually sent out at the end of each month

If you have not received it, check your junk/spam mail and if it is not there, please contact the office to confirm we have your correct email address.

Other club notices are also emailed if there is something urgent to share with you eg COVID updates as an example.

If you do not have an email, you can pick up a hard copy from the office.

In House

Whilst you are in the clubhouse you will see TV monitors in various locations throughout the building. These provide you with information about competitions, club events and changes to course conditions / local rules etc. There is also one dedicated to Club History.

So check them out before or after your game.



WHEN CAN I PLAY?

Your membership category will determine your playing rights.

Once you have a handicap, we encourage you to play in our competitions.

It's a great opportunity to meet other members at the Club and to learn more about golf, including etiquette and the rules.

Feel free to put your name down with anyone using the 'Bookings' link in the Members Section on the website.

USING THE MICLUB APP VIA THE WEBSITE

- Login to the Members Section
- Click "Bookings"
- Find the date you wish to play and click "OPEN"
- Select the preferred time you wish to play, and then click "BOOK ME"
- The screen will refresh back to the timesheet showing your booking
- To delete your booking, just click the Red 'X' next to your name
- You can book playing partners by using the "BOOK GROUP" option next to the time. Complete the details required on the next screen.

If you don't have internet access at home, you can book a game on the computers at the Club. There is one in the Pro Shop and another two upstairs to the left of the entrance door. You can also book a game by phoning the Pro Shop.

If you have a preferred start time, we recommend that you to log and book as soon as the relevant booking sheet becomes available at 5:00am, 7 days before each competition.



ON THE DAY I PLAY

It is recommended that you arrive at least 30 minutes before your tee time - this allows time to register for the competition on the terminal inside the ProShop, pay your competition fees and check the Local Rules Board situated outside the shop entrance.

Players will be called to the tee approx. 10 minutes before they are due to hit off.


