



LOCAL RULES

1. Sprinkler Heads - Within 2 club lengths of the green or the ball is 2 club lengths from a sprinkler head and is on the line of play. Relief is allowed under Rule 16.1(a).
2. Wheel tracks on fairways, outcrops of rocks, artificial surfaces and imported materials on paths and roads are Abnormal Course Conditions and relief may be taken without penalty.
3. Tree Roots - relief allowed if interfering with players intended swing, NOT stance, through GENERAL area, Nearest point of relief drop.
4. Buggy signs and hoops through the green are movable objects and must be replaced after shot is played.
5. Bridges on 12th and 13th hole on the fairways are Abnormal Course Conditions and nearest point of relief may be taken without penalty.
6. All penalty areas and GUR stakes are Immoveable Objects and relief may be taken without penalty except if the ball is in the penalty area.
7. All defined garden beds are COMPULSORY relief, one club length nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.
8. Fences on the 3rd, 8th and 12th are Line of Sight relief.
9. All boundary fences and black and white pegged areas are OUT OF BOUNDS and a provisional ball must be played from the point of origin of first shot. If the ball is OUT OF BOUNDS stroke and distance applies.
10. If your ball strikes any powerlines, electrical towers/poles on the course you MUST replay your shot without penalty anywhere on the course
11. The area between the 4th and 5th holes is ALL penalty area.
12. The area around the 4 buggy sheds are OOB as defined by black and white pegs, hit provisional ball if unsure.
13. If your ball lands on the road or gutter behind the 2nd green go to the dropping stake Relief is 1 club length from the stake. A free drop applies. If your ball goes into the garden bed you are Out Of Bounds and must take stroke and distance.
14. Blue Zones - If your ball crosses the penalty area defined by blue markers estimate your point of entry, go to the nearest blue peg drop zone and drop within one club length of the stake, 1 shot penalty is incurred.
15. Bare patches on the fairways are free relief drop.
16. Mulch spread on the golf course is an integral part of the course play as it lies.
